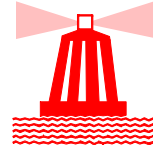

## IMPALA EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2006

### NOTICE OF RACE

- **ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

The organising authority is Neyland Yacht Club, The Promenade, Neyland. Telephone (01646) 600267, fax @ Marina Office (01646) 600713. Secretary: Gwyn Phillips Tel: 01646602050, Class Captain: Fred Fisher, Tel: 01646600697

- **LOCATION AND DATES**

The Championship shall be sailed in the approaches to and the Milford Haven Waterway on 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2006.

- **RULES**

The event shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) (2005-2008), the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association (RYA), the Impala 28 Offshore One Design Class Rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments hereto.

- **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible to enter this Championship, yachts shall comply with the Class Rules and shall be helmed by a member of a yacht club recognised by the National Authority of the country from which the yacht is entered.

- **ENTRIES**

Entries shall be on the attached entry form and shall be received by the organising authority on or before 18<sup>th</sup> June 2006. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee. Entry forms and fees should be mailed to: **Gwyn Phillips, 10 Promenade Drive, Neyland, Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire, SA73 1QD**

- **ENTRY FEE**

The entry fee shall be £100, payable with application for entry. Cheques should be made payable to 'Neyland Yacht Club'.

- **REGISTRATION**

Entrants shall register with the Race Office, situated at Neyland Yacht Club, between 09:30 and 17:00 on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2006 or between 09:00 and 09:30 on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2006.

- **PROGRAMME OF RACING**

The programme of racing will consist of seven races as follows:

Every endeavour will be taken to stick to the above format; however the Committee may change the order and/or type of race dependant on weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

- **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

- **SCORING & DISCARDS**

The RYA Low-Point Scoring shall apply. All races shall score equally. Three races completed shall constitute a Championship, and, should five or more races be completed, one race shall be discarded.

- **ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES**

A yacht infringing a rule of Part 2 of RRS may exonerate herself in accordance with RRS 44.2 (720 degrees turns penalty)

A yacht touching a mark may exonerate herself in accordance with RRS 31.(360 degrees penalty)

- **PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to first, second, third, fourth and fifth places overall and to first place in each individual race. The overall winner will be presented with the European Championship Trophy.

- **INSPECTION & MEASUREMENT**

Yachts may be inspected and measured at any time before or during the event. Failure to comply with Class Rules may lead to disqualification from the event. Sail inspection will take place on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2006.

- **CHARTS**

The racing area is covered by Admiralty Charts numbers 2878, 3274 & 3275.

- **INSURANCE**

It is the duty of each owner to have his/her vessel insured against any risk, including civil responsibility to third parties.

- **SOCIAL PROGRAMME**

There will be a full social programme including Opening Reception and Prize Giving Dinner.

- **FACILITIES**

Free cramage will be provided by Dale Sailing Co. for those boats towed to the event. A concessionary rate of £10.00 per night berthing at the Marina will be provided by Neyland Yacht Haven.
